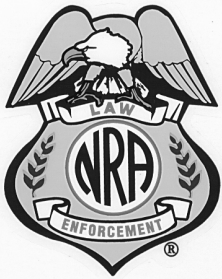


Curriculum Vitae:

Ron Hoague began a career in Law Enforcement in 1991 when he joined the Police Department in the City of St. Albans, VT. Hoague attended the Vermont Police Academy in 1992. A year after graduation, he moved to the Town of Essex, VT Police Department in 1993. During his tenure there as a patrol officer, Hoague was a department leader in DUI arrests. He also was a member of the department's SWAT team as a designated rifleman. He completed both basic and advanced training as a police sniper with Sgt. Ed Gross of the Keene Police Department and Crosshairs, Inc. Also, as a member of the SWAT unit, he went through basic entry training at the Vermont Police Academy with Law Enforcement Training Services, Inc. Hoague was the department's lead trainer in defensive tactics, baton and OC usage after completing certification by Monadnock, Inc, in 1996.



Ron Hoague moved to Florida in January 2000. After obtaining certification from the Florida Department of Law Enforcement, Hoague was hired by the Volusia County Sheriff's Office and assigned to the civil division. Hoague left Volusia in October of 2000 and was hired that same month by the Marion County Sheriff's Office. He attended the DUI detection and standardized field sobriety testing course from the Institute of Police Technology and Management in July of 2003. In February 2004, Hoague was assigned to the Sheriff's traffic unit as a DUI specialist. Since then, he has accumulated a significant number of DUI arrests, being recognized by the MADD organization for arresting 100+ DUI violators in each of the years 2004 and 2005.



Hoague holds an Associate of Applied Science Degree in Criminal Justice from Kaplan University, having graduated Summa Cum Laude. In May 2006, Hoague completed the Drug Evaluation and Classification Program's 16 hour pre-school and 56 hour Drug Recognition Expert School at the Institute of Police Technology and Management in Jacksonville, FL. Hoague completed the Field Certification Phase and became certified as a Drug Recognition Expert in August, 2006. His certification is endorsed by the International Association of Chief's of Police.

Since moving to Florida, Hoague has also furthered his training in firearms and tactical disciplines. He has completed several handgun and tactics courses with Adler and Associates International to include Combat Handgun, and Vehicular Combatives. In 2004, Hoague completed training with the Tactical Firearms Training Team, an organization operated by Max Joseph, former member of Marine Force Recon. This training encompassed Advanced Tactical Handgun and Two-man Team Tactics. Hoague received his certification as a Firearms Instructor in 2003 and as a FL-CJST instructor in 2004. Since then he has been employed as a Firearms Instructor with both Central Florida Community College and the Marion County Sheriff's Office. He has shared his knowledge of firearms and tactics with the students in both Corrections and Law Enforcement Academies. He has been a range master for the Sheriff's Office since 2006. In 2007, Hoague became certified

as an NRA Patrol Rifle Instructor after completing the course endorsed by that organization.

During nearly sixteen years of Law Enforcement and training experience, Hoague has consistently been committed to enforcing DUI law and training. He has conducted more than two thousand investigations involving people who are intoxicated or under the influence of drugs. He has arrested hundreds of DUI violators and a similar number of persons for drug possession violations. Further, Hoague has built a considerable knowledge base in firearms and tactics. From defensive tactics and precision rifle shooting, to handgun and patrol rifle disciplines, Hoague's knowledge of the shooting arts is extensive.
